Calculus AB-BC: Dr. Janice Rech is an Associate Professor of Mathematics at UNO and focuses on the teaching and learning of mathematics. Dr. Rech works closely with high school AP* Calculus teachers in UNO's Dual Enrollment program.

Chemistry: Dr. Edmund Tisko is an Assistant Professor of Chemistry at UNO. He teaches General Chemistry and Physical Chemistry. Dr. Tisko has also taught college preparatory chemistry at the high school level.

U. S. History: Dr. Bradley Dyke has taught US History and Political Science at the high school and college levels. Before retirement, he served as the Program Chair of Political Science at the Des Moines Area Community College. Dr. Dyke is a consultant for the College Board's AP US History and is a reader for the AP* US History examinations.
