ID# Theatre students seeking a focused major must apply via the faculty adviser for admission upon completion of 39 credit hours that include: ENGL 1150, ENGL 1160, CMST 2220 or CMST 2120, MATH 1310 (or above), Social Science 6 credit hours, Natural/Physical Science 4 credit hours, THEA 1000 three semesters, & additional THEA coursework totaling 9 credit hours. To remain in good standing in a focused major, a student must: 1.) Complete all required focused curses with a grad of 'B' (3.0) or above 2.) Prepare a resume, portfolio review, or acting audition each semester THEATRE CORE REQUIREMENTS 38 hrs. Theatre Lab is required each semester for a total of 8 semesters. Transfer students with less than 5 semesters of anticipated residency will need to enroll in more than one hour of Lab in some semesters to meet requirements.
