BASA Student Exhibition Guidelines and Requirements: Spring 2015

Student Eligibility Requirements:

• Eligible students must have applied for graduation with a Bachelor of Arts in Studio Art degree by the University deadline (normally the end of the 9th week of classes).*

Artwork Eligibility Requirements:

- All work submitted must be produced in a studio art course at UNO. An exception will be
 made for works of photography produced in courses taken at Metro through the Metro/UNO
 cooperative degree program or taken in a UNO course outside the Art Dept.
- Only works not shown in a previous UNO Gallery exhibition are eligible for the exhibition.
- Works must be selected with the approval of your studio faculty mentor.
- Work must be assigned a sale price (preferred) or if NFS (not for sale), an insurance value. Works labeled POR (Price on Request) will not be accepted.
- The UNO Art Gallery retains a 20% commission on sale of all works. And the Gallery will handle sales.
- Students may submit 1 3 works depending on size of the work and number of students in the show. (If space is limited, the Gallery may select only one of the submitted works to exhibit.)
- All work must be framed and ready to install.
- Works that use paint or other materials that off-gas must be completely dry and odorless before installation.
- Any electrical components must be pre-approved by the UNO Gallery Coordinator and the Criss Library Building Manager.

Labeling and Statements

All participating students must provide the gallery coordinator with label information for the selected works AND a brief artist's statement or (for graphic design students) a design rationale of no more than 200 words, two weeks prior to the exhibition. (This semester these texts are due not later than April 30.)

Label information to include: 1) artist's name as on gallery label 2) title of work 3) media 4) dimensions in inches h X w X d 5) sale price OR insurance value if not for sale 6) semester, course & teacher the work was created for.
