

## APPROVED COURSE OPTIONS FOR THE THIRD REQUIRED COMPOSITION COURSE

Criminal Justice majors are required to complete a minimum of nine hours of **Composition** course work. **Be careful!** There is a difference between Composition (writing based curriculum) and Literature (reading based curriculum). This pertains to the Composition requirement. Literature courses count in the Humanities. Students may complete the Composition requirement in one of the following three ways:

1. Those students who place into English 1150 will be required to take 9 hours of English Composition (ENGL 1150, 1160, and 2400 or another 2000 to 4000 level composition course on the approved list of courses or approved by the Criminal Justice academic advisor).
2. Students who test out of English 1150 and are placed in English 1160, will be required to take 6 hours of English Composition (1160, and 2400 or another 2000 to 4000 level composition course on the approved list of courses or approved by the Criminal Justice academic advisor).
3. Those students testing out of both English 1150 and 1160 will be required to take 3 hours of English Composition (English 2400 or another 2000 to 4000 level course on the approved list of courses or approved by the Criminal Justice academic advisor).

**The Department of Criminal Justice Curriculum Committee has approved the following courses to fulfill the third Composition course required at the 2000 to 4000 level. If there is a course offered that is not on this list, please contact the criminal justice academic advisor for approval prior to registering.**

**ENGL 2400** Advanced Composition  
Prereq: ENGL 1160 or permission.

**ENGL 3000** Writing for the Workplace  
Prereq: ENGL 1160 or permission. (No other ENGL 3000 counts)

**ENGL 3980** Technical Writing Across the Disciplines  
Prereq: ENGL 1160 or permission.

**ENGL 4880** Community Service Writing  
Prereq: ENGL 1160 with a grade of "A" or "B".

**JOUR 2100** Media Writing  
Prereq: ENGL 1160.  
Coreq: JOUR 2104.

**JOUR 3220** Critical Writing for the Mass Media  
Prereq: ENGL 1160, junior.

**JOUR 3270** Public Affairs Reporting  
Prereq: JOUR 2150 and 2160 or permission of instructor.

**JOUR 3400** Magazine Article Writing  
Prereq: JOUR 2150, junior, or permission of instructor.

**JOUR 4220** Literary Journalism  
Prereq: ENGL 1160, junior.

**MGMT 3200** Managerial Communications  
Prereq: ENGL 1160, SPCH 1110 or 2120, all graded "C" or better, 2.3 GPA or higher.

**WRWS 2000** Special Studies in Writing  
Prereq: ENGL 1150.

**WRWS 2050** Fundamentals of Fiction Writing  
Prereq: ENGL 1160.

**WRWS 2060** Fundamentals of Poetry Writing  
Prereq: ENGL 1160.

**WRWS 3000** Selected Topics in Writing  
Prereq: Varies according to specific topics being offered.

**AVN 3060** Writing and Research in Aviation  
Prereq: ENGL 1160, AVN 1000, SPCH 1110.
