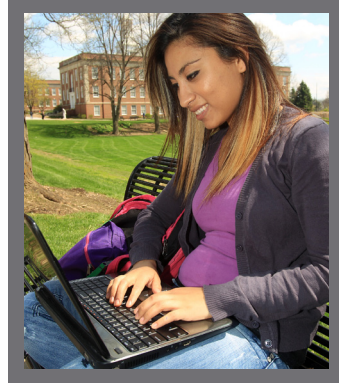


Nonprofit professionals are in high demand:

BGS Degree



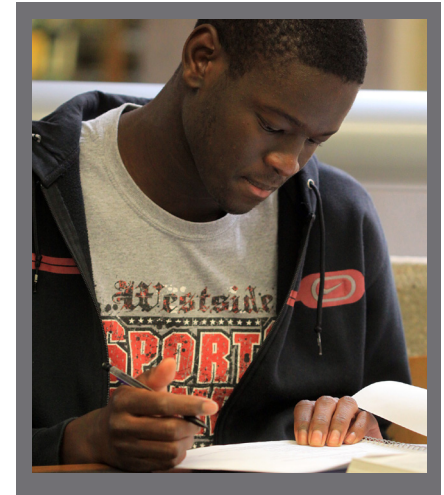
The Bachelor of General Studies (BGS) degree is a fully accredited 120 credit hour undergraduate degree program for students 21 or older. Awarded to over 22,000 students since 1951, all courses are taught by University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) faculty.

The BGS degree prepares graduates to

meet a wide range of academic and professional goals. Students pursue a liberal arts education, highly valued in today's workplace for developing critical thinking and decision-making skills. The degree emphasizes multidisciplinary study, providing the graduate with a well-rounded background. If you've delayed your education, the BGS degree will help you thrive in today's competitive work environment.

The BGS in Nonprofit Administration is one of only four undergraduate degrees in the nation that focuses specifically on nonprofit management. UNO's School of Public Administration, a national leader in civic education with several nationally ranked graduate programs, coordinates the course offerings. The concentration consists of 30 academic credit hours of nonprofit administration courses. Courses are offered online and will rotate each academic year.



Students may register for as many or as few classes as their schedules allow. UNO's online courses are highly interactive, with faculty and students communicating through e-mail, discussions, and chat groups.
