

## Fire

UNO buildings have fire detection and/or fire sprinkler systems that are equipped with a signaling system commonly referred to as a "fire alarm". Fire detection and fire suppression systems in permanent buildings send alarms to Campus Security. The exception to this are the Annexes (temporary buildings). The alarms in these buildings are local alarms only. The fire alarm sound in most buildings is a steady tone that indicates evacuation is required.

### (Small Fires)

UNO employees are not expected to try to extinguish small fires unless they are confident in doing so and they have received training in this area. "Small" fires are defined here as a fire that can be controlled with one portable fire extinguisher. Examples of small fires might be found in trash cans, laboratory hoods, etc. The early stages of small fires may not put a heat detector, smoke detector or sprinkler system into alarm, so it is important to notify Campus Security of the incident. Security Officers will respond to verify that the fire has been extinguished and will replace the used extinguishers.

### (Fire Emergencies)

For fires requiring additional action:

- a. Pull the nearest fire alarm pull station,
- b. Evacuate the building. If you are conducting class make sure that all students have cleared the room.
- c. Provide assistance to anyone with special needs.
- d. Contact Campus Security to verify that a fire emergency exists in your building.
- e. Do NOT Use Elevators. Those with disabilities should proceed immediately to the designated stairwell area where emergency personnel will assist them. Designated assembly points for the disabled are listed below.
- f. Proceed to your rally point. The rally point for each building is for faculty and staff only. Students are not required to assemble at the rally point but must leave the building. You should stay at the rally point until you have been excused by the emergency personnel.
- g. Do NOT re-enter a building unless informed it is safe to do so by emergency personnel.
