

## Tornado

When severe weather is present listen to KVNO-FM radio 90.7 for announcements.

A **TORNADO WATCH** means that tornadoes could develop.

A **TORNADO WARNING** means that a tornado actually has been sighted somewhere in the general

area. If the warning sirens are sounded or if you have been notified of a WARNING or a tornado is

sighted approaching campus:

- 1) Campus Security will contact building managers or other building occupants.
- 2) Proceed immediately to the interior hallway on the lowest floor or basement, unless there are boilers or electrical switch-gear areas housed in the basement. The designated shelters are as follows:

Building	Shelter Area
AH	Offices 109 and 114, first floor bathrooms
ASH	First floor, interior rooms on the South side
Alumni	Basement level rooms 030-032, Boot Strapper Hall (107)
Central Utilities	Under stairs lower level
CBA	Lower level auditorium, rooms 002-009
DSC	Lower level rooms 013-019
EAB	Lower level East storage area <i>except 040D</i> ; central hallway, and rooms 009, 011-014
ENGG	East side: Lower level rooms 003B, E, G and H; South-west side: lower level offices 030-038
FH	Lower level locker rooms, North addition 003, 005, 007, 009
Fine Arts	Lower level west hallway
HPER	Lower level hallway areas (racquetball court level)
KH	First floor <i>except mechanical rooms; stairwell</i>
Library	First floor rooms 102 (except Lounge), 103, 107A
MBSC	First floor TV lounge
PAC	First floor rooms 107, 110-112, 120-127
Parking	Lower level stairwells
PKI	Central East side hallways
Sculp/Ceram	HPER Lower level hallway areas (racquetball court level)
Annexes	Basements - <i>not in furnace/boiler room</i>

- 3) If time does not permit, get into the safest area of your classroom or office (the inside wall away from the doors and windows).
- 4) Avoid windows, auditoriums, gymnasiums or other structures with free-span roofs and boiler or electrical switch-gear areas.
- 5) Take shelter underneath your desk or any heavy furniture available.
- 6) Assume a curled position protecting your head and eyes.
- 7) All persons should remain in the shelter areas until advised the warning has ended. There is no siren signal for ALL CLEAR. When a warning has ended, the cancellation will be given by the radio stations or Campus Security.
