Retroactive Credit & Advanced Placement Policy

Retroactive Credit Option

Students can apply for retroactive credit for ENGL-1150 (with a grade of CR) if they meet the following conditions:

- Place into the 116 level by the Department of English's English Placement and Proficiency Examination (EPPE) **or** present a score of 4 on the Advanced Placement (AP) examination taken on or after August 25, 2008 (either Language and Composition or Literature and Composition exams) **or** have been placed via the ACT during June or July of 2010 **ONLY***; and,
- Take and successfully pass (with a C- or better) ENGL-1160 or ENGL-1164 **at UNO**.

Students can apply for retroactive credit for ENGL-1150 and ENGL-1160 (with grades of CR) if they meet the following conditions:

- Place into the 200 level by the Department of English's English Placement and Proficiency Examination (EPPE) or present a score of 5 on the Advanced Placement (AP) examination taken on or after August 25, 2008 (either Language and Composition or Literature and Composition exams); and,
- Take and successfully pass (with a C- or better) an approved "third writing course" **at UNO**.

Advanced Placement

The English Department at UNO uses scores on the Language and Composition or the Literature and Composition Advanced Placement (AP) examinations to place students into appropriate English composition courses at UNO based on the following scale:

- AP score of 3--placement into ENGL-1150, Composition I.
- AP score of 4--placement into ENGL-1160, Composition II.
- AP score of 5--proficiency in ENGL-1150 and ENGL-1160, Composition I and II.
