

Phi Delta Gamma

Amount to be Awarded: \$500.00/student (three awards)

Guidelines:

The purpose of the Phi Delta Gamma scholarship shall be to encourage and assist men and women of promising talent and ability to complete the requirements for a graduate degree at the University of Nebraska Omaha. Three scholarships of \$500.00 may be awarded once during a school year to three students who have been ***accepted into a graduate program and have completed nine (9) graduate hours within their degree program***. They shall be registered for six (6) or more graduate hours in the semester during which the award is granted.

The scholarships shall be awarded as follows:

- The Office of Graduate Studies at the University of Nebraska Omaha shall announce and receive applications for the Phi Delta Gamma Scholarships. Each application must be supported by **two letters of recommendation from Graduate Faculty members and one letter of recommendation from an outside person acquainted with the applicants' character, leadership ability, and promise of success.**
- The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of ability and the promise of success. Ability shall be evaluated in terms of excellence in academic scholarship, character, leadership and personality.
- The Dean for Graduate Studies shall review credentials of all applicants and from the best qualified, in his/her judgment, selects the scholarship winners.
- Previous Phi Delta Gamma recipients are not eligible.
