### Businesses Exempt from the distance restrictions:

Drug store (limited)  
Grocery store (limited)  
Grocery store (general)  
Hotel (general)  
Restaurant (limited)

Those highlighted in yellow indicate a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) all others require a Special Use Permit (SUP)

**Special Use Permit (SUP)** - will be required by businesses that have characteristics that require special consideration and pose a greater risk to the community. Special use permits will be reviewed by the Planning Board and are subject to discretionary approval by the City Council.

**Conditional Use Permit (CUP)** - will be required for those businesses that are exempt in the matrix above and are considered to have characteristics that pose less risk to the community. Conditional use permits are reviewed and subject to discretionary approval by the Planning Board.
