Foreign Language (24 Qtr Hrs / 16 Sem Hrs)

Additional College of A&S Requirement for Bachelor of Arts Students ONLY

A BA degree requires two years of the same college foreign language (or four high school years of the same foreign language). Any one of Mid-Plains CC foreign languages (levels I-IV) can transfer to meet this requirement. Students planning to take additional foreign language courses at UNO will take a Foreign Language Placement Exam.
