Students will be permitted to enter the College of Business Administration with junior class standing and to transfer the maximum allowable credits (99 quarter hours) earned in the Associate in Applied Science – Business Transfer degree, given the following condition: Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher as well as a "C" or better in each course.

NOTE: A grade of C+ or higher is required for all courses required for a primary or secondary specialization such as Marketing, Finance and Banking, and Management. See current UNO catalog for complete list.
