Solomon Girls Center Summer Program

Needed: Fine Art, Education, Black Studies, Recreational, Physical Education and Visual Communication Classes

This program serves girls in northeast Omaha. We are looking for classes that could provide instruction in the fine arts, such as visual arts, dance, drama and music during our summer program. Solomon Girls Center is open for instructions in other disciplines. The program runs from June 5, 2006 to August 4, 2006, with a parent's program on the last day. Domestic Abuse Program

Needed: Criminal Justice, Social Work, Education and Psychology Classes

Social work, criminal justice and special education students would receive practical experience in working with troubled and challenged youth. Especially needed is instruction on life skills – anger management, trust issues and society issues. Since many of the students will be out of school for the summer, we need classes to come in and teach skills during the day.

Community Relations Department

Needed: Spanish, Journalism, Communication, Public Relations, Marketing and Visual Media Classes

Designing and writing of brochures and booklets are needed in the Community Relations Department. Class projects could also include surveys, video production and designing marketing plans for volunteers and donors.
