The University of Nebraska at Omaha has implemented a Youth Activity Safety Policy to provide a safe environment for youths participating in activities, clinics or conferences.

Our policy includes safe interaction guidelines including sex offender registry checks for Activity Workers. This policy will help to protect participating youths from potential misconduct incidents and help provide a safe, educational and enjoyable activity/program experience. Key provisions of this policy include:

1. All Activity Workers must successfully pass a sex offender registry search for Nebraska and the state(s) they reside.
2. All Activity Workers driving activity vehicles must successfully pass a Driving Record Check.
3. In the case of an emergency or accident involving your youth, parents/guardians will be notified, following notification of the appropriate emergency personnel.
4. All UNO activities will comply with UNO's Youth Activity Safety Policy and Activity Worker Guidelines.
5. As parent(s) or legal guardian(s) you give permission to this activity to use photos of your child in promotional media, unless specifically restricted by checking this box and initialing :

The activity directors of University-sponsored activities, clinics and conferences reserve the right to immediately dismiss any youth from the activity, clinic or conference for disruptive or endangering behavior. ## University of Nebraska at Omaha Guardian's Release of Claims

Guardian wished Minor to participate in the Recreational Activity provided by the University of Nebraska at Omaha commonly known as Mav Kids Youth Programs. In consideration for the privilege of Minor's participation in this activity, Guardian agrees to the following clauses:

1. Guardian certifies that Minor is physically capable of participating in Mav Kids Youth Programs and the he/she will take responsibility for physical fitness and capability to perform under the normal conditions of Mav Kids Youth Programs.
2. Guardian has hereby been made aware that Minor's participation in Mav Kids Youth Programs has the following non-exhaustive list of particular risks: cardiovascular stress, sprains, strains, abrasions, dislocations, fractures, concussions, contusions, blisters, death, and injury during travel to and from field trip sites, and the reckless conduct of other Recreational Activity participants.
3. Guardian, with the intention of binding him/herself and Minor and their respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, assumes all risks in connection with participation in Mav Kids Youth Programs and hereby releases all instructors, agents, operators and officials of the University of Nebraska at Omaha from liability for any injury or damage which may befall Minor while participating in Mav Kids Youth Programs, and agrees to save and hold harmless the University of Nebraska at Omaha and its heirs, legal representative, and successors and assigns against loss from any further claims, demands, or actions that may subsequently be brought by Minor or by any other person or persons arising out of the Minor's participation in Mav Kids Youth Programs.
4. In case of medical emergency, Guardian authorizes the University of Nebraska at Omaha or its representatives to take all reasonable steps to secure the health and safety of Minor, including, but not limited to ambulance transportation, x-ray examinations, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and/or hospital care.

Guardian certifies that he/she is of lawful age and legally competent to sign this affirmation and release that he/she understand that the terms contained herein are contractual and not mere recitals.
