#### ACTIVITIES:

We are a recreational day camp and our basic activities are recreation in nature. Our campers rotate through various physical activities including swimming, rock climbing and gym games. #### MAV KIDS STAFF:

# Registration

## Payment

\$40 deposit required for each child/each session. **Deposits are non-refundable and cannot be used towards another weeks balance**. This deposit will be applied to the total cost of the session(s). Registrations will be accepted in person at the Health, Physical Education and Recreation (HPER) Building Control Desk. ### \$140/Week

**UNO Campus Rec Member:** The membership allows individuals to participate in Campus Recreation Activities. UNO students pay fees that allow them to participate. UNO Faculty/Staff must purchase a Membership (it is not part of your benefits package). UNO Alumni and UNMC students, faculty, and staff are eligible to purchase a membership, as well. The membership fee is comparable to what the students pay in their UPF fees. You must be a current Campus Recreation member while your child is attending camp.

**UNO Student:** Any person enrolled at UNO paying UPF fees to the UNO campus.

### \$160/Week

Non-Member: Anybody that is not a current UNO student or Campus Rec Member.
