To nominate a person or persons for the Mary Ann Lamanna Award for Excellence in Women's Studies, please submit the following *in electronic form* to Dr. Wendy Guo (wguo@unomaha.edu):

1. A 1-2 page nomination letter describing the nominee's accomplishments and their relevance to the UNO Women's Studies program. *The nominator must be connected to the Women's Studies program (student major/minor, faculty, staff).*
2. The nominee's/nominees' resume or c.v.
3. Additional supporting materials (e.g. letters of support) are welcome but not required.

The person(s) selected will receive the award at the annual Women's Studies luncheon. This year's luncheon will take place on Friday, April 30, 2010.
