SUMMER GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

Eligibility:

Any student who satisfies all the following conditions is eligible for consideration for the 2011 Summer Graduate Scholarships:

1. Admitted as a degree seeking student at UNO, are currently enrolled in at least three (3) graduate hours or is a candidate for a doctoral degree program at the time of application.
2. **Masters and EdS students:** at the time of application must have completed twelve (12) graduate hours within a graduate program;
doctoral students: an approved program of study on file in the Office of Graduate Studies.
3. Graduate grade point average of at least 3.75.
4. 2-4 letters of recommendation.

Selection Criteria:

The following will be considered in evaluating the applicants for the Scholarships:

1. Outstanding academic performance and potential;
2. Published papers/studies (basic or applied research) and presentations to disciplinary or professional organizations;
3. Outstanding professional work in practicum or agency settings, if applicable;
4. Community and professional service as a graduate student or volunteer.

It is not expected that every applicant must satisfy all the above criteria; applicants will be judged on the quality of their performance in those areas appropriate to their discipline or profession.
