## PHI DELTA GAMMA SCHOLARSHIPS

1. The purpose of the Phi Delta Gamma scholarships shall be to encourage and assist men and women of promising talent and ability to complete the requirements for a Graduate Degree at the University of Nebraska at Omaha.
2. Three scholarships of \$500.00 may be awarded once during a school year to three students who have been accepted into a graduate program and have completed nine (9) graduate hours within their degree program. They shall be registered for six or more graduate hours in the summer semester of which the award is granted.
3. The scholarships shall be awarded as follows:
  - a. The Office of Graduate Studies at the University of Nebraska at Omaha shall announce and receive applications for the Phi Delta Gamma Scholarships. Each application must be supported by **two letters of recommendation from Graduate Faculty members and one letter of recommendation from an outside person acquainted with the applicant's character, leadership ability, and promise of success.**
  - b. The scholarships shall be awarded on the basis of ability and the promise of success. Ability shall be evaluated in terms of excellence in academic scholarship, character, leadership, and personality.
  - c. The Dean for Graduate Studies shall review credentials of all applicants and from the best qualified, in his or her judgment, select the scholarship winners.
  - d. The scholarship may be granted to an individual only once. (It is not renewable).
