

SUMMER GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS January 2008

Eligibility:

Any student who satisfies all the following conditions is eligible for consideration for the 2008 Summer Graduate Scholarships:

1. Currently enrolled in at least 3 graduate hours or a candidate for a doctoral degree at the time of application. Admitted as a degree seeking student at UNO.
2. *Masters and EdS students: completion of 9 graduate hours within a graduate program; doctoral students: program of study approved.*
3. Graduate grade point average of at least 3.75.
4. 2-4 letters of recommendation.

Selection Criteria:

The following will be considered in evaluating the applicants for the Scholarships:

1. Outstanding academic performance and potential;
2. Published papers/studies (basic or applied research) and presentations to disciplinary or professional organizations;
3. Outstanding professional work in practicum or agency settings, if applicable;
4. Community and professional service as a graduate student or volunteer; and
5. Potential for completing program of study during Summer 2008.

It is not expected that every applicant must satisfy all the above criteria; applicants will be judged on the quality of their performance in those areas appropriate to their discipline or profession.

A completed application form, together with a current résumé and **at least two and no more than four** letters of recommendation. Other relevant information may be submitted as specified in the application form.

Deadline:

The deadline for the submission of all application materials to the Office of Graduate Studies is **Friday, February 8, 2008.**
