

## Prefix: Existing and New

Subject codes, also known as prefixes, are front-facing PeopleSoft Codes. When an existing program undergoes a name change, the college/department/school may request that the name change be accompanied by a prefix change.

Prefix changes can only occur for future enrollment terms. **Deadline for Fall enrollment is February 1<sup>st</sup>.**
