What is a Colloquium?

Colloquia are interdisciplinary courses offered by the University Honors Program, engaging students to develop out of the box critical thinking and writing skills. Colloquia often carry general education credits.

*What are "Other Honors Credits"?

24 Honors credits are needed for Honors transcript and diploma recognition. 12 of those credits are obtained by completing the 1st semester Honors-only course, 2 Honors colloquia, and Honors thesis/capstone/practicum course (major course options may be available here too). The remaining 12 credits can be obtained in many ways, including:

- Contracts
- Additional Honors courses
- Internship
- Study Abroad

Sample Honors Course Progression

Below is one *example* of how you can earn Honors credit each semester. The exact classes you choose to take (and the order) may be different but you must take an Honors-only class in your first semester.

Other Important Information

- ***All incoming first-year students are required to take an honors-only course in their first semester
- Students must earn a B or higher in a course to earn Honors credit
- All students will create a portfolio of their efforts by the 5th week of their last semester. It must attest to their achievements in Undergraduate Research, Community Engagement, and Campus Citizenship
- Students are expected to undertake at least one Honors course/option each semester at UNO; students may sit out of Honors for ONE semester without losing Honors priority registration privileges
- Students may undertake up to 2 contract options each semester and up to 12 contract credit hours total during their degree
