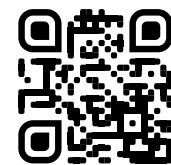

TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed transferable coursework from a regionally-accredited collegiate institution following high school graduation
- Graduated from a regionally-accredited high school or completed the equivalent academic training (GED)
- Meet the GPA requirement for the program to which you applied
- Be in good academic standing at your previous institution(s)

Transfer Credit Requirements

- Credit is only accepted from regionally accredited two- and four-year colleges or universities
- A grade of C- or higher must be earned in course to be accepted for transfer
- A maximum of 64 semester hours can be transferred to UNO from a two-year institution
- All credit hours transferable are converted to semester credit hours
- Grades earned at another institution do not become a part of the student’s UNO cumulative GPA, unless earned at another University of Nebraska campus
- Final determination of transfer credit and how it applies to your area of study will be decided by an academic advisor in your program

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

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NEBRASKA INCOME TAX CREDIT

Students who do not qualify for Nebraska resident tuition but work in Nebraska and pay Nebraska income taxes are entitled to tuition credit upon documented evidence. The credit is meant to offer a tuition break and cannot be used to lower tuition below the normal charge for resident students.

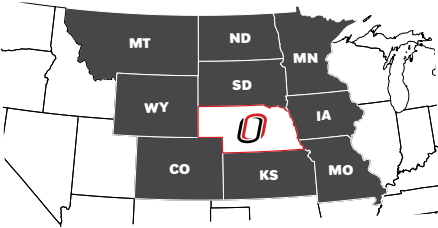
