

FALL 2019-20 PARKING UPDATES

No Permit Price Increases: 2019-20 permit prices will not increase. They will remain the same as 2018-19.

Updated Hourly/Daily Parking Locations: Pay-to-park options in Lots A, C, and M will change slightly. All other hourly/daily permit locations can be found on the Parking Services website.

Lot A	Student pay to park lot only. Must use Park Omaha App. Two-hour limit at \$1/hour
Lot C	Visitor-only parking from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M.
Lot M (7 spaces)	Visitor-only parking from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M.

Two Vehicle Limit to Register to Permit: Vehicle registration linked to your permit purchase, will be limited to two vehicles. If you drive more than two vehicles, you must delete one of the vehicles to add a third prior to parking on campus. Accounts with more than two vehicles must be reduced to two prior to July 1, 2019.

Carpool Program Changes: The carpool program will improve for faculty/staff and students. There will be options for surface and garage permits with tiered discounts ranging from 30% to 100%. More information will be found on the Parking Services website this summer.

ONE WEEK ONLY – FREE Pacific Street Garage Parking: During the first week of Fall Semester classes, August 26-30, the Pacific Street Garage will offer free parking for general use stalls.

Effective September 3, 2019: Violation Waive Policy to Change: In an effort to not increase permit fees and reduce student fees, the academic waive violation will no longer be available for faculty/staff, students and residents. The appeal process is also available for evidence that the violation was not committed or was due to circumstances beyond the driver's control.

REMINDERS

Sustainability Reminders: Parking Services offers sustainable commuting and parking options for faculty/staff and students. These include free rides on Metro buses, discounted carpool permits, electric vehicle charging stations, and the Emergency Ride Home Program.

Open Parking Reminder: Fridays boast open parking in general use spaces in the garages ONLY on Dodge Campus and the garage and faculty, staff, and student surface lots ONLY on Scott Campus. Tow list vehicles must not park until parking balance is \$0 on MavLink/MavPark.

Garage Permit Restrictions Reminder: Valid lots for garage permits from 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. are:

East Garage - Student: Lots T, V, Pacific St. Garage (PSG) Only

West Garage - Student: West and PSG Only

Pacific St. Garage - Student: PSG Only

CEC Garage: CEC and PSG Only

East Garage - Faculty/Staff: Lots U, T, PSG Only

West Garage Faculty/Staff: West and PSG Only

Pacific St. Garage - Faculty/Staff: West and PSG Only
