Multidisciplinary studies integrates knowledge and methodologies from multiple disciplines or fields of study, emphasizing the connection of different areas of knowledge, diverse perspectives, and methods. **A multidisciplinary studies degree is most beneficial for those returning to school after taking a break, those professionals who need a 4 year degree for advancement within their current industry, or those with qualifying credit hours.**
