The cognate should be chosen in consultation with the major/faculty advisor if not already designated in the major requirements.	
<b>University General Education RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can double-count with minor and/or major</li> <li>• 6 credits can count toward BS Cognate</li> <li>• 5 credits can count toward BA Foreign Language</li> </ul>	<b>Option 1 RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can use toward University General Education</li> <li>• Cannot double-count with BS Cognate</li> <li>• Only double-counts with 1st major as much as both programs allow</li> </ul>	<b>Option 2 RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can double-count with major</li> </ul>	<b>Option 3 RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• See "Major" column for more info on rules</li> </ul> <b>For 2<sup>nd</sup> majors:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• See respective major department for double-counting rules, if applicable</li> </ul>	<b>BA Foreign Language RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can use 5 credits toward University General Education or Option 2 Additional General Education</li> </ul>	<b>BS Cognate RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can use 6 credits toward University General Education or Option 2 Additional General Education</li> <li>• In most cases, cannot double count with Option 1 minor or Option 3 second major</li> </ul>	<b>Major Coursework RULES:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can double-count with University General Education</li> <li>• Can double-count with Option 2 Additional General Education</li> </ul>
