## New Student Next Steps

We recommend taking care of the below items as soon as possible to ensure a successful start at UNO:

- ☐ Download the 1-Check UNO app and use it daily before coming to campus.
- ☐ Pick up your UNO face masks and Durango Days Welcome Bag.
  - Locations are listed online (search “Durango Days Welcome Bag” at [unomaha.edu](http://unomaha.edu))
- ☐ Upload your picture for your MavCARD and pick up your MavCARD.
  - Upload a photo using the GET Mobile app.
  - Call 402.554.2220 to schedule an appointment for identification verification and pick-up.
    - Pick-up location: MavCARD Services Office - Milo Bail Student Center 2nd floor

- ☐ Finalize any financial aid and scholarship requirements.

- ☐ Buy your parking pass. Virtual passes can be purchased online.
- ☐ Familiarize yourself with UNO maps and shuttle routes.
- ☐ Buy your textbooks.
  - At the UNO Bookstore, you may charge up to \$1,500 to your Student Account using your MavCARD and pay later.
- ☐ Complete your Title IX Training prior to the start of classes.
  - Prior to the start of classes you will receive a notification in your UNO email to take this training.
- ☐ Review your class schedule in MavLINK for any classroom/mode of instruction changes.
- ☐ Log into important UNO accounts:
  - Microsoft 365 (Outlook)
  - Canvas
- ☐ Go over what your first week will look like. The better prepared you are, the easier it will be.
  - Are you commuting to campus?
  - Where are you going to park?
  - What is your work schedule?
  - Will you use the campus shuttle system?
- ☐ Use the campus maps to think through your daily schedule at UNO.
  - Where are your classes located?
