August 25

Fall Classes Begin!

- Walk through campus the week before to fine your classrooms
- Check Canvas for the Class Syllabus and read it ahead of time
- · Mark your calendar with test and assignment due dates



September 2

Last day to drop a Fall class and receive a %100 refund. **Last day to add** a Fall class in MavLINK without special permission from the instructor.

Make sure you like your schedule!

After this, all class dropped will show on your transcript as a "W." W's do not affect your GPA, but Graduate/Medical/Law schools do not like to see them.



September 7

Last day before 11:59pm to withdraw via MavLINK from a course with a grade of "W" and receive a 75% refund.



September 14

Last day before 11:59pm to withdraw via MavLINK from a course with a grade of "W" and receive a 50% refund.



September 21

Last day before 11:59pm to withdraw via MavLINK from a course with a grade of "W" and receive a 25% refund.

After this, you will have to pay full tuition and fees for any classes you drop.



October 22

Around this time, enrollment for Spring 2026 will begin. Plan to meet with your academic advisor!

Every semester, **you must meet with your Academic Advisor** before you can register for next semester's classes. Make an appointment at <u>mavconnect.unomaha.edu</u>!

You'll talk about: How this semester is going, your interests in Majors and Minors, and the best classes for your goals/interests next semester.



November 7

Last day to drop, audit, or CR/NC a Fall class. No refunds will be given.

Time to start studying for finals! A little bit a day goes a long way.



December 13

Last day of Fall classes.

Plan study breaks during finals week. Being well-rested helps you remember!

Final exam week!
