Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to Aim for the Stars 2023! Please share this information with the person who will be picking up your child. Your patience is necessary as we do our best to keep your child safe. Please inform whoever will be dropping off and picking up children of these instructions. Your child's safety is of paramount importance to us. General information:

- Medicine, epi-pens, inhalers and other medications to be administered at camp must be in the original prescribed container (exactly as you would at school). On the first day of camp, bring any medication to the Camp Director, Erin Dahl, Krista Testin, or Sandy Bolamperti as you arrive on Monday morning.
- Campers bring a sack lunch each day and a bottle of water (can refill here).
- If picking up early, please call at least 30 minutes prior pick-up (402-554-4999). Your child will be brought to the northwest entrance of Allwine Hall. (No early dismissal between 2:45p.m. 3:30p.m.)
- We are in a new building this year, Allwine Hall. It is located behind the student center on the south side. Drop-off and pickup will be on the top floor of the EAST Parking Garage.
- If your child is going to be absent, please call 402-554-4999 to let us know.

<u>Morning Arrival:</u> Loop through the top floor of the East Parking Garage-<u>PLEASE SEE MAP ON NEXT PAGE-</u> <u>THE RED LINE IS MORNING DROP-OFF</u>

- <u>Monday-No earlier than 8:15 a.m.</u> Children walk up unescorted, as counselors will have signs. Counselors will check in their campers outside. T-shirts, nametags, etc. will be given in the classrooms.
- <u>Tuesday-Friday Arrival:</u> No earlier than 8:15a.m. Children walk up unescorted, as counselors will be there to meet them.
- Follow all directions that staff give you for dropping of campers, we have worked with Campus Security as to the best and safest route to use. All questions or concerns about drop-off can be directed to Erin Dahl, 402-554-4999.

<u>Afternoon Dismissal:</u> Loop through the top floor of the East Parking Garage. Dismissal will be in the same place as drop-off is in the morning. <u>Please do not park</u>. <u>PLEASE SEE MAP ON NEXT PAGE-THE BLUE LINE IS</u> <u>AFTERNOON PICKUP</u>

- Dismissal begins at about 3:25 p.m. Please do not come too early; coming a little later to pick-up will help speed up the process. <u>PLEASE follow the loop of traffic through the top floor of the parking garage</u>. (see map). Be patient, we will work as safely and quickly as possible.
- Follow all directions that staff give you for picking up of campers, we have worked with Campus Security as to the best and safest route to use. All questions or concerns about drop-off can be directed to Erin Dahl, 402-554-4999.
- Should we have lightning during dismissal, campers will be taken to the first floor of Arts and Sciences. It is the building directly north of the parking garage. Counselors will relay names to the waiting campers so they can run out to their car. Should you decide to wait out the storm and come a little later, that will be fine. Just come into the building to room 100 using the southeast entrance and walk straight down the hallway.
- Adults unwilling to abide by these instructions may be asked to keep their child at home (no refund).
