In this forum, expert speakers will discuss research on healthcare practices for transgender individuals; people's experiences with the healthcare system; and research on human rights protections (or their lack) for transgender and gender nonconforming individuals.

Panelists will also discuss missing and murdered women and gender-nonconforming individuals in Indigenous communities. The event will bring to light research on overlapping human rights concerns for people who are marginalized both because of gender presentation and because of membership in other minoritized groups.
