

Presentation: "History for the Common Good: A Philosophy for Public History at UNK."

Speaker: Dr. Jinny Turman is an assistant professor of history at the University of Nebraska at Kearney specializing in modern U.S., social, and public history. Her research interests include the history of the environmental movement, the 1970s-era "back-to-the-land" movement, and countercultural thought. Her recent articles are focused on "green" civic republicanism and definitions of the "common good". She is a member of the National Council on Public History and American Association of State and Local History, and she serves on the Advisory Board for the G.W. Frank Museum of History and Culture, Board of Directors for the Buffalo County Historical Society, and Board of Directors for the Nebraska State Historic Preservation Office.
