

Land Management Internships at UNO's Glacier Creek Preserve Summer 2023



Internship Description:

- Glacier Creek Preserve is looking for up to **3 (three) Land Management Interns** for Summer 2023. The Internship, which involves physical labor in summer field conditions, will assist in activities primarily located at either **Glacier Creek Preserve** or **T. L. Davis Preserve**.
- Oversight of the Internship Program is the responsibility of the Preserves Director with on-site supervision provided by the Land Management Specialist.
- Interns are expected to work a minimum of 125 hours between mid-May and mid-August with a minimum of 12 hours per week. Specific schedules will be arranged with the Land Management Specialist.
- A \$1000.00 stipend will be paid on completion of the internship.

Activities may include: 1) Invasive species control (mechanical and chemical), 2) Native prairie seed collection, 3) Tree and brush cutting and clearing, 4) Assisting with prescribed burns, 5) GPS data collection, 6) Assisting with research and monitoring projects, 7) General repair and maintenance of existing structures and equipment, 8) Grounds maintenance, and 9) Assisting with Volunteer workdays and other activities that may occur during the internship.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must be current college-level students or recent college-level graduates and must be at least 18 years old.
- Applicants must be in good physical condition and willing to work outdoors in summer conditions.
- Applicants must be willing to use or learn to use hand tools, including loppers, hand saws, weed eaters, and backpack sprayers.
- Applicants selected must sign waivers of liability before beginning the internship.
