Father Desbois is a French Roman Catholic priest, founder and president of Yahad-In Unum, a global organization dedicated to identifying the sites of Jewish and Roma who perished in the Holocaust by Bullets, and to spreading universal awareness of the ongoing epidemic of genocide. Father Desbois has received numerous honors for his groundbreaking work, including the Humanitarian Award from the US Holocaust Museum and the 2017 Lantos Human Rights Prize.
