6th Annual Creative Writing Contest in Spanish

A Spanish language writing contest open to all students grades 5-12 in the state of Nebraska

Sponsored by the Department of Foreign Languages, Masters of Arts in Language Teaching (MALT) Program, Office of Latino/Latin American Studies (OLLAS) and College of Arts & Sciences at the University of Nebraska at Omaha.

Latinos and Latin American immigrants make up about 10% of the Nebraska population. Their language, as well as their contributions to urban and rural communities, can be found everywhere. The Department of Foreign Languages and the Office of Latino/Latin American Studies at the University of Nebraska at Omaha have launched the 6th Annual Creative Writing Contest in Spanish to celebrate the Spanish language and encourage its creative use among heritage and bilingual speakers, and speakers of Spanish as a second language.

SUBMISSIONS:

This year's selected genres are *historieta* or comic and poem/short story.

- Historietas should be 6-15 frames long. Illustrations may be black and white, or color in any media. No clip art will be accepted. Authorillustrator teams are welcome.
- Poem (10-30 lines long) and short story (250-600 words) should be inspired by a work of art housed at either the Joslyn Art Museum (JAM) or El Museo Latino, both located in Omaha. Part of the JAM's collection is accessible online. We encourage an actual visit to these museums whenever possible. The submission must indicate title and location of inspiring work of art.
- No online translators or translating software will be accepted.
- Use of Word spelling and grammar-checking tools is highly recommended.
- Submissions must be submitted electronically and by mail.
- ♦ Deadline: March 18, 2015.

- ♦ Grades 5 & 6
- Grades 7 & 8
- ♦ Grades 9 & 10
- ♦ Grades 11 & 12

AWARDS:

- ♦ There will be a first and second prize for each category and genre. Prizes will include electronic and print books, e-dictionaries, and art supplies.
- Honorary mentions will receive award certificates.
- ♦ The Awards Ceremony will take place at the UNO campus in May 2015 (date to be announced).
- Award-winning and selected entries will be displayed at UNO Criss Library Main Floor Gallery in June-August, 2015. Poems and short stories will also be exhibited next to the inspiring work of art at the Joslyn Art Museum.
