Ramón Guerra examines contemporary Chicana and Chicano narratives that resist and expand established literary historiographies. His dissertation, "Literature as Witness: Testimonial Aspects of Chicano Self Identity Narratives" investigates how Chicana/Chicano narratives provide self-historicizing perspectives. These testimonios reveal previously erased interpretations of literary history.
