Associate Prof. Justin Skirry (Nebraska Wesleyan University), Dr. Justin Skirry is Associate Professor of Philosophy at Nebraska Wesleyan University. Dr. Skirry's research interests focus on Early Modern Philosophy (ca. 1600-1780) with a particular emphasis on the metaphysics of Descartes (1596-1650) and its relation to the later Medieval, scholastic philosophical tradition. He has published two books on Descartes: *Descartes and the Metaphysics of Human Nature* (Continuum Press, 2006) and *Descartes: A Guide for the Perplexed* (Continuum Press, 2008).
