Cognate Requirement (15)

- **A minimum of 15 credits of cognate coursework in other disciplines (chosen in consultation with a faculty advisor)**
- At least 9 of the 15 credits must be at the 2000 level or higher
- Courses used to satisfy general education requirements may NOT be credited as cognate coursework
