

# Behavioral Intervention Plan

A FORMAL WRITTEN PLAN MADE FOR A STUDENT TO PREVENT BEHAVIOR THAT GETS IN THE WAY OF LEARNING AND TEACH HELPFUL BEHAVIORS.

## 1 Includes a description of what the behavior of concern looks like:



Current frequency (how often or how long the behavior happens or the intensity of behavior) of the problem behavior

## 2 Why the problem behavior may be happening:



This is usually based on a functional behavioral assessment that looks at what might trigger the behavior and what happens after the behavior

## 3 The Intervention might:



**Prevent** the problem behavior by altering what happens before the behavior occurs



**Teach** the student other more appropriate behaviors to do instead of the problem behavior



**Reward** appropriate behavior and decrease motivation to do problem behavior

## 4 A way to measure if the intervention is working (data)
