POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The graduate assistant appointment will be for one academic year (August 19, 2020 to May 15, 2021) and will average 20 hours of work per week. The position includes a full tuition remission (including summer), health care benefits, and a stipend of approximately \$13,800. Graduate assistants are not allowed to hold other employment during their appointment. Students are expected to complete SOC 8030, 8040, and 8050 before or during their appointment.

The duties of the position will be split between teaching and research with the proportion agreed upon by the GPC and the GA. At least 10 hours will be devoted to teaching and at least 5 hours devoted to research. The teaching responsibilities for the upcoming year will include, but are not limited to, helping teach the lecture and/or lab exercises and holding office hours for the undergraduate statistics class/statistics lab and research methods class/research methods lab. The research responsibilities will include working directly with a faculty member on a research project in a shared area of interest.
