1. A one or two page nomination letter describing the nominee's accomplishments and their relevance to the UNO Women's and Gender Studies program. *The nominator must be connected to the Women's and Gender Studies program (student major/minor, faculty, staff).*
2. The nominee's/nominees' resume or c.v.
3. Additional supporting materials (e.g. letters of support) are welcome and strengthen the nomination but are not required.
