
**Our goal is to help you become a more confident, independent writer.**



5 TEXT CHAT: You can use the text chat tool, available by selecting CHAT below, to have a text conversation with other participants. If you do not want participants to see what you are typing as you type, turn the REAL TIME option off.

7 AUDIO AND VIDEO: If your institution has enabled audio and video consultations, you will be prompted for camera access when first joining a session. To be prompted again, simply refresh this screen. Screensharing is also available by selecting the computer icon in the audio and video area.

8

9 TOOLBAR: The icons on the left side of the toolbar allow you to work with a document's formatting. Other icons provide access to drawing tools, math tools, and import/export options. Hover over an icon to see what it does.
