Candidates must meet the minimum qualifications listed below. Scholarships recipients are selected and awards disbursed in August 2020 for use in the upcoming 2020-2021 academic year.

- Overall grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25
- Accounting (or other upper-level major classes) with interest in IT Auditing and Security or MIS GPA of at least
 3.50
- Level of extracurricular activity involvement (specifically members of student organizations, preferably academic).
- Level of volunteer activity involvement (members of charitable organizations or participants in charitable events, volunteering in audit-related organizational events)

In commemoration of ISACA's local Omaha Chapter, the Michael T. Hoesing's Memorial Award for this year is for \$2,000 (3 Awards).
