Requirements and Guidelines

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours) in the School of Communication through at least December 2016.
2. Student must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average overall.
3. Student must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average within his/her major.
4. **All applicants must submit the following:**
 - a. A School of Communication internship scholarship application form.
 - b. A 1-page typed resume to include all relevant communication experience (student publications, broadcasting work, internships, work experience, etc.) Be detailed about the position and duties. Also include on and off campus honors, activities and offices.
 - c. A 1-page typed essay detailing future career aspirations/goals
 - d. One letter of recommendation is required from an instructor, internship supervisor or employer.
 - e. A list of previous scholarships and scholarships you will have during the upcoming academic year.
 - f. Names, addresses, telephone numbers of two references and your relationship to them. (teacher, employer, etc.)
5. Provide an unofficial transcript.
6. **Must** be a Journalism or Broadcasting major and doing an Internship in a newsroom at a local media outlet.

Please note, if you receive financial aid and/or grants, this may affect your ability to obtain the entire scholarship.
