HISTORY	6 hrs.

Students must take <u>two</u> history courses for a total of 6 credit hours. Any history course (HIST 1000-4999) will count for this requirement, but students should consider topics that relate to their art historical interests.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT 16 hrs.

Students must complete <u>four</u> consecutive semesters (two academic years) of the same language. This requirement will be waived if students have completed four years of one language in high school. Language options: French, German, or Spanish.

ART ELECTIVES	9 hrs.

Students must take <u>three</u> additional courses to supplement their academic degree for a total of 9 credit hours.

These courses can be more art history classes, studio art classes, arts management classes (see the arts management req./electives for Option B) or theatre classes (e.g., THEA 3760, THEA 4780, THEA 4790). Students can consult with a faculty member for other class options.
