Kristina (Tina) Peterkin is the director of clinical education for UNO's Speech Language Clinic. Tina coordinates all clinical experiences with our community partners for the graduate speech-language program including pre-externships, medical externships, and educational externships.

### What led you to choose a career in Speech Language Pathology?

I was accepted into and ready to attend law school, but I realized that I did not like conflict. I decided to take the Meyers Briggs test and speech language pathology (SLP) was off of the charts for a match. Also, my grandmother was an SLP in 1937. I graduated from UNO with my master's degree in speech language pathology in 1995. I served as a pediatric SLP and assistant professor at Creighton University.

# What type of specialty work have your done within speech language pathology?

I have contributed three articles to ASHA Leader with one, A Dizzying Condition, being about my own personal journey with vestibular crisis and rehabilitation. I was then asked to be the guest speaker for the New Jersey Speech and Hearing Webinar series in December 2018. I presented on the role of speech language pathologists in vestibular rehabilitation.

I grew up sailing in Minnesota. I had the opportunity to sail off of the coast in Wales, UK while I was studying there as an undergraduate. It was an amazing experience.
