Fast-Track Approval

Fast Track offers highly qualified and motivated students the opportunity to complete a bachelor's degree and a master's degree (this does not apply to graduate certificates) in an accelerated time frame. With Fast Track students may count up to 9 graduate hours toward the completion of their undergraduate program, as well as the graduate degree program.

Eligibility:

- Must have a minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 (some programs may have higher requirements).
- Eligible students must have completed no less than 60 credit hours.
- This form, with all signatures, must be submitted to the Office of Graduate Studies prior to enrolling in your first graduate course.
- Students will work with their undergraduate advisor to register for the graduate course(s).
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the graduate courses is required to remain in good standing.
- Students remain undergraduates until they meet all requirements for the undergraduate degree, and are eligible for all rights and privileges granted to undergraduate status, including financial aid.
- Near the end of the undergraduate degree, formal application to the graduate program is required. The
 application fee will be waived; the applicant will need to contact the Office of Graduate Studies for a fee
 waiver code (gradschool@unomaha.edu). If admitted, the admit term for the graduate program must be
 after the completion term of the undergraduate degree.
