Students are responsible for meeting the specific prerequisites of the upper level business co-requisite courses. Students must see an IS&T academic advisor regarding the specific requirements for their major. Students may follow the UNO catalog requirements in effect at the time of their first enrollment, provided continuous enrollment is maintained (fall, spring, fall, spring....). Students are accountable for prerequisites of all courses listed. Thirty of the last 36 hours must be University of Nebraska at Omaha courses. Up to 4 semester hours of different physical education activity courses may count toward the degree. A repeated course may count only once for graduation. (Exceptions are internships, independent studies, physical education activity courses, and special topic courses, provided each course is a new topic.) ENGL 1050, ENGL 1090, ENGL 1100, MATH 1010, and MATH 1210 do not count as part of the 120 credit hours required for the degree program.
