The Aeronautics and Space Science Program at Burke High School along with the Aviation Institute at the University of Nebraska at Omaha are pleased to announce an Internship opportunity for an aviation major or minor.

The intern will work with the UNOAI Flight Training Coordinator and the Burke High School instructor to teach the Private Pilot Theory class to Burke seniors. This is an opportunity for the intern to receive hands on teaching and curriculum development experience as a CFI. Students will be assigned specific curriculum areas, develop the corresponding courseware and then teach the information to the high school private pilot ground school class.

The intern must be available on the day and times that the Burke High School class is offered. They must work a minimum of 8 hours per week either teaching in the classroom or preparing for lecture. Interns will submit their courseware to receive UNO academic credit for the internship. Successful completion of this internship will result in 3 credit hours in AVN 4200 or AVN 8030.

The duration of the internship is one semester, and it is unpaid. To apply please submit a resume and cover letter.
