This paid internship offers valuable exposure to all aspects of operating and managing corporate aircraft, providing students with real-world experience in business aviation. Depending on scheduling, interns may also have the opportunity to ride along on corporate flights, gaining firsthand insight into executive air travel operations.

Interns are expected to work approximately 20 hours per week, with flexible scheduling available during normal business hours. Most work will take place at Midwest Aviation's hangar at Eppley Airfield.

To be eligible, applicants must have at least junior standing in the UNO Aviation Institute program, maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher, and demonstrate a strong interest in business aviation as a career path. Candidates must also be able to pass a background check for Airport ID clearance.
