## Distribution of age 20+ population with an associate degree by race, ethnicity, and gender



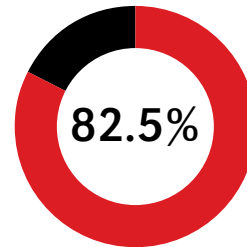

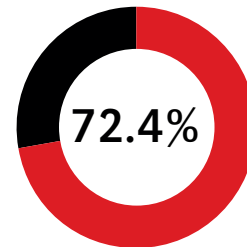
