

Gaylene Armstrong, Ph.D.

Dr. Gaylene Armstrong is the Director of the University of Nebraska at Omaha, School of Criminology and Criminal Justice. Dr. Armstrong received her doctorate in criminology and criminal justice from the University of Maryland in 2000. Gaylene is a nationally recognized expert in the area of adult and juvenile corrections. Professor Armstrong has published two books and over 40 journal articles and book entries. She has also helped to secure more than \$1 million in external funding to support her research. Professor Armstrong previously served as a professor and the chair of the Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice at Sam Houston State University, and prior to that she held faculty appointments at Southern Illinois University and Arizona State University.
